To the Court of Commissioners for the granting of

Gentlemen

We your petitioners learn with regret
that an application is about being presented to your
Court for a licence for a second publick House
in this neighborhood - and believing as we do that
a second place of that kind is altogether unnecessary,
that one Hotel is quite sufficient for the accommodation
of the traveling Publick - more especially is it so now
since the Warkworth and Pukekohe Road is being made
passable - and being aware of the evil tendency which
almost invariably prevails wherever spiritous liquors
are vendid. your Petitioners would humbly pray
your Honorable Court to disallow a licence
to a second Publick House in this neighborhood
